Here's my subcommittee report for inclusion in the minutes for the Aug. 27 Area meeting ...

The Hospitals and Institutions Subcommittee had another productive meeting prior to the ASC meeting on Sunday, Aug. 27. We continue to meet at 1 p.m., prior to the start of Area at 2:30 p.m. We continue to carry a message of experience, strength and hope into six facilities, with 10 different panels:

- 1) A men's meeting and a women's meeting at the Anderson County Jail
- 2) Meetings every Wednesday and every other Saturday at Center Pointe
- 3) A meeting at Gateway, a facility for adolescent males in Blount County
- 4) A men's meeting at the Knox County Sheriff's Department Detention Facility
- 5) Three meetings at Peninsula Hospital: One for adolescents, and two panels (one on Mondays and another on Thursdays) for adult detox patients
- 6) A women's meeting at the Sevier County Jail

As always, we need continued support from members of Narcotics Anonymous. We encourage GSRs to announce in their homegroups that H&I needs support, and for those with 90 days or more clean and an interest in service work to contact panel leaders. Attached is a revised H&I flyer with up-to-date contact information for panel leaders and trusted servants of the H&I subcommittee.

Our literature expenditure for the August subcommittee meeting was \$399.93 - 7 cents under our \$400 limit. Thanks to literature chair Randy F. for his work, and to all subcommittee members for continuing to carry a message to those who can't get out to meetings on a regular basis.

Recovery On The Ridge XI— Brent E : Hey everybody,

ROR is over and we hope everybody had a great time. We had lots of support and we also had a lot of help at the event. Many addicts pitched in and worked hard all weekend to

help the committee. We will have a total accounting of funds by next month, after all the checks have cleared and receipts are totaled.

We think the area should direct ROR to leave behind a larger amount of seed money for the incoming committee to work with. If next years event is to held in April or May, then the committee will have a lot less time to raise funds for the event. Several people have expressed the willingness to serve on the committee for ROR 13. We hope to see a chairperson nomination in the near future, like today.

We did have an isolated incident involving a person attending our campout. We were faced with the tough decision of having to call the park ranger to have a man removed from the camp. After a brief committee meeting on Saturday night, we decided the welfare of the group, fellow campers and their children was more important than what the park thought of us. We felt that this individual was a danger to himself and to others. We stand behind our decision to ask for help with a potentially very dangerous situation, and in the end we felt it worked out for the best as the person was given a ride by recovering addicts, back to his home in Knoxville, instead of being taken to Union county jail. This was a very intense situation and we appreciate all the help and support of our fellow addicts who got involved and helped us deal with it. We would like to give a special thank you to the addicts who put themselves at risk by giving this person a ride back to town. As it turned out they should not have been put in that position and thank God nobody got hurt. In my opinion the three addicts who gave this person a ride home, performed the most incredibly selfless act of service we saw all weekend.

This incident did not change the fact that we had a very good overall event; however it may have left a lasting impression with Big Ridge state park. The park ranger said "with 250 addicts up here, if we only have a problem with one of you then we're doing pretty well" The rangers were very cool last weekend and said they had no complaints with us.

I have had a very good experience with this service commitment and I am grateful for this opportunity to serve my fellow addicts. The addicts who served on the committee for this event are an example of unity and commitment in this fellowship. It has been an honor to serve alongside them and I have learned a lot from them. THANK YOU.

Nomination Results

Nomination #1

Made by Hugs Not Drugs and seconded by Serenity In The Smokey's to nominate Ethan for Alternate Treasurer of G.S.M.A.S.C . This nomination passed with 12 yes /0 no/1 abstention.

Motion Results

Motion #1

Motion made by Spiritual Principles and seconded by Saturday Night Live. The motion states that the G.S.M.A.S.C. approve the phone line guidelines. This motion passed with 11 yes/1 no/1 abstention.

Motion #2

Motion made by Spiritual Principles and seconded by Hugs not Drugs. The motion states that the G.S.M.A.S.C. approve the PI guidelines.

This motion passed with 10 yes /1 no/ 2 abstention.

Motion #3

Motion made by Happy Hour and seconded by Just For Today. The motion states that we pay the Show Me Region Office the amount of \$262.55, due to 60 introductory guides to NA (\$107.10) being lost in transit and \$155.45 that was due to an over ordering of literature in July's order. Motion was revoked due to the maker not being present.

Motion #4

Motion made by Nickel and Dime and seconded by Spiritual Principles

The motion states that we approve the budget for the phone line subcommittee in the amount of \$2000.00 a year. This is only an estimate due to the fact that the phone service charges its customers based on the amount of time that it is in use. The estimate is \$125.00 per month, times 12 months in a year equals \$1500.00, with the additional \$500.00 for advertising

One month's base service charge is \$55.00. For every minute of use, we are charged an additional .08¢. To advertise our number in the yellow pages and to receive information fliers we are charged an additional \$500.00 per year. This motion passed with 12 yes/ 0 no/ 1 abstention.

Motion #5

Made by the Happy Hour Group and seconded by Together We Can. The motion states that any addict wishing to fill a vacant service position in our area must state their clean date. This addict's clean time must coincide with the clean time requirements stated in our by-laws. This motion passed 11yes/ 0 no/ 1 abstention.

Motion #6

Made by Happy Hour Group and seconded by Together We Can

The motion states that a live person answers the phone when a still suffering addict calls regardless if it is our area or our region. This motion was ruled out of order because it is an issue that should be handled by the phone line subcommittee.

OPEN FORUM

Jeff B.: I feel that R.O.R. owes James an apology for the way in which he was treated at R.O.R. XI. The incident was not handled in a professional manner and we need to make amends to the park and to the addict that was involved in the incident.

Chris W.: I would like to hear from the individual in question.

Rex C.: We are humans first, and addicts second. We must use reason and logic in our decision making processes.

James: The whole incident was blown out of proportion. I was not acting harmful to myself or to others. Even though I had my own ride coming to get me, I want to thank those who took me home.

Phil B.: It is not our position to determine the level of professional help that someone needs. This is why it was suggested to James that he get professional help.

Chris W.: Newcomers that are coming to my home group are afraid to share because they have been asked not to cuss at other meetings.

Glen: This is my first time here at area, and I am trying to start a new meeting. I would like to ask for help in forming this new meeting. I know several members of the Volunteer Group that are willing to help me. I have knowledge of what is needed to form a home group. I would also like to ask for a starter kit.

David E.: We are \$640 over our prudent reserve. Think about this as the 7th tradition basket is being passed at your home group.

Karen T.: In response to Chris W's comment on no cursing. We do that because of an individual that was cursing profusely in front of some young children. We felt that our spirituality would be of a higher quality without cursing at our meetings. If you come to our group, we ask you not to cuss out of concern for the children that are often present at our meetings. This was a decision made by Just for Today's group conscience.

Greg V.: In response to Glen's request for help in starting a new meeting, I would suggest that you get involved with a home group for a while, then branch out and form a new meeting. I would also like to announce that Spiritual Principles is currently seeking a new location for holding our meetings. We have outgrown our present location, which is currently a church. The church has informed us that they want to feel free to speak with addicts at our meetings regarding their particular religious beliefs. We are currently on a hunt to find a new location for our meetings. If anyone has a potential meeting locations please let us know.

James H.: In regards to Glen's request for help in starting a new meeting, all you need to have a meeting is a location, a time and date and two or more addicts. If you can get that started, come back and we can definitely get you a starter kit.

NEW BUSINESS

Motions

Motion #1. Made by Little River Group, Seconded by Together We Can. To turn ROR into an Area Convention. Intent: Rebuild area unity in regards to the area inventory.

Discussion

Kara C.: The intent of this motion is to rebuild unity in the area. Based on discussion at our last area inventory, ROR is ruining our area. We need an area convention.

Chris W.: Is the motion doing away with ROR and replacing it with an area convention?

Kara C.: No, we just want to make it an area convention.

John: Would it be a VRC fundraiser?

James H.: It is a simplified way of getting funds to the area.

Chris W.: If we want to have a convention, we should have one.

Walker: I am still confused as to the purpose of this motion.

Angie P.: My suggestion has been to disband ROR in hopes of coming up with some way of creating unity. ROR scavenges the area for money, every event all year long is raising money for ROR. Several homegroups are frustrated that fundraisers all year long are for ROR. This convention would be overseen by the area.

John: This motion seems to be about money, not unity.

Angie P.: Many homegroups in the area need help. This way the money would stay in the area.

Jason S.: If we approve this, we would be giving the individual NA member the choice of what to do with the money.

Chris W.: We could just hold back enough money from each ROR to fully fund the next one.

Walker: I want the motion simplified.

Motion #2. Made by Spiritual Solutions, Seconded by Spiritual Principles. Combine Public Information and Phoneline subcommittees to unite in Narcotics Anonymous' single purpose of carrying the message to the addict who still suffers. Intent: Many subcommittee members and trusted servants serve on both service bodies, it would inspire unity and organization so that process can be made more efficiently.

Comments from the maker: Six people are attending both subcommittee meetings. Having one hat for all of these functions would allow all the positions to be filled. We are finding it takes a unified effort for everything to flow. (see pg. 54 in GUIDE TO LOCAL SERVICE)

Greg V.: As a member of both of committees, I am in favor of this motion.
