Motion #1 was made by Walker, KANA H&I Chair, and seconded by Bob McD, Chattanooga and reads as follows:

To supply the Knoxville Area H&I Sub-committee with enough basic text for the Knox County Penal system. We are asking for \$495.00, any left over funds will be used for other H&I literature such as the White Booklet.

Intent: To supply the message to addicts who still suffer literature who can't get out and get it any other way.

Discussion of motion:

Question – Can your Area provide the Literature?

Question – Would this be a duplication of services by the Greater Smokey Mountain?

To start the VRSC meeting at 9:30 and to only take a 30 min. lunch.

Intent: To be more prudent with our time we are here.

Action taken:

Motion thrown out by Regional Chair because this is already in our agenda.

Motion #3 was made by Craig G., VRSC Sec, and seconded by Jason R., Midwest Area RCM, and reads as follows:

Changing the guidelines by removing Article 1X, Section 3, Letter A, and by changing Article 1X, Section 3, Letter C to say “The purpose of the Administrative Committee meeting is to discuss and share information regarding issues between subcommittees and the Executive Committee to expedite discussion at the RSC.

Intent: To eliminate contradiction in our guidelines.

Action taken:

Deferred to Policy and Procedures.

Motion #4 was made by Lucy O, VRSC Alt Sec., and seconded by Bob McD, Chattanooga, and reads as follows:

Add to guidelines under Article X: voting; Section 1, Letter J: Voting on all

CAR/CAT motions shall be done on a group by group basis with all RCM's bringing the groups' votes to the region where the total number of yes, no and abstention votes are tallied. In the event of a tie, the RD will take a vote of abstention.

Intent: So the vote reflects the true conscience of groups in the Region.

To change regional meetings to 4 times per year once each quarter.

Intent: To cut expense and try to gain participation from some to serve.

Motion #6 was made by Chattanooga Area and seconded by West Tn. Area and reads as follows.

To change VRC Guidelines as follows:

Under Convention Information – Responsibilities:

3. Schedule 2 distributions (at RSC) and 1 mailing (in June) as follows:

a) 100 pre-convention flyers handed out to each area at the Feb. RSC

b) 100 flyers handed out to each area at the August RSC

c) 50 flyers mailed to each Area outside the Region that is within 200 miles of the host city

d) 50 flyers mailed to each Region within 700 miles of the host city

5. In July, mail 1 flyer to each individual from outside the host city who registered for the prior year convention.

6. Delete – (no mailings to the WSC)

7. Delete – (no mailings to the World Convention)

Under Arts & Graphics – Responsibilities:

Section 2. – (pre-convention flyers) change “1,000 to be delivered to current VRC Convention” to “500 to be delivered to current VRC Convention”

Intent: to reduce the convention expense for printing and mailing flyers, since addicts are more likely to register from a flyer printed off the internet than from flyers distributed through the mail.
