Hello Family,

Our current accounting balance is \$3,004.36. We look at to see if we need to send anything to region, (\$3,004.36 - 2,179.86 \$=824.50). This is \$1,558.84 below our prudent reserve. The reason why the area is below our prudent reserve so much is due to a couple of reasons. One of those reasons is due to a lack of area donations from home groups. Also, the literature subcommittee was on back order due to the lack of a chair person. The literature subcommittee is building back up the literature stock pile. There was money in the bank account that had not been used yet by the Literature subcommittee. This made it look like there was more money in the account than there was, because the literature subcommittee hadn't used this money yet. I do not want to take away the importance of the fact that there has been a lack of donations made by home groups. I was not able to attend the ROR subcommittee meeting for March, because it got cancelled.
