Hello Fellow Members,

Our current balance is \$3,483.40. We have a donation to present to the Region in the amount of \$709.10. This leaves us with a balance of \$953.40 above our prudent reserve.

I was unable to have a Transaction History at today's meeting due to AmSouth being closed yesterday. David and I went to a couple of branches with no success. I had hoped to show him how simple it was to acquire that printout. Once I get the Transaction History I will email it (along with the rest of my report) to our Secretary.

I have included the past month's Income/Expense Report and the Year To Date Report. Please note that I have pulled out the rent expense incurred by H & I from the monthly rent for the ASC. I have done this with the subcommittees so that it would give a clearer picture as to the expenses our subcommittees have. This will help with the annual report for the Region.

Last month I had stated that if you wished we could schedule another meeting to review the Audit Information. Since then I have received no request from anyone to plan this meeting. Therefore, I will provide a consolidated report at our next meeting to be included in our minutes.

I have purchased a copy of Quicken Basic for our Alternate Treasurer and I am presenting a receipt for \$32.76 for reimbursement. David came over to my house yesterday and we installed the software along with the current backed up database that I have been generating and working with on to his computer. He and I will be working together to see that he is comfortable with this software with regard to making entries and generating reports.

Last month Brent asked about the funds raised for VRC prior to the convention itself: below is a table for the past three VRC's that shows the amount of income, expenses and balance the day prior to the conventions:

The Hospitals and Institutions Subcommittee of the Greater Smoky Mountain Area of Narcotics Anonymous had another successful subcommittee meeting prior to the Area meeting on May 28. We started early, at 11:30 a.m., with a H&I Orientation presented by Steve W. and Mark L.; it was well-attended, with about 10 addicts, including a new panel leader, in attendance. The subcommittee meeting was attended by 17 panel leaders, members and guests. Subcommittee vice-chair Adam L. resigned his position as Thursday night panel leader for Peninsula Hospital's Adult Detox program; Steve H. was voted in as the new panel leader. The subcommittee voted to add a new panel - a Wednesday night meeting at Helen Ross McNabb's Center Pointe facility, strictly for the detox patients. Walker (?) was voted in as the panel leader for that particular panel (Mark L. will continue to serve as panel leader for the Saturday night Center Pointe inpatient meeting). It should be noted, however, that the vote was not unanimous; three members of the subcommittee dissented out of concern the subcommittee is spreading itself too thin. Their concern was highlighted by the resignation of Bill (?) as panel leader for Anderson County Jail's men's H&I meeting, as well as the dwindling support the Anderson Co. jail women's meeting receives and the Knox County Detention Center receives. As always, H&I needs the support of Narcotics Anonymous members, especially those willing to carry a message into jails and detention facilities.

The subcommittee will next meet at **noon** on June 25, prior to the 1 p.m. meeting, to discuss purchase of a stamp for H&I-distributed literature (as suggested in the WSO's H&I handbook). The subcommittee will convene at 1 p.m., prior to area.
