RCM Report- These motions were taken care of at region so DO NOT vote on them.
Motion #1 was made by Chatanooga Area and seconded by West Tn. Area and reads as follows.

To change VRC Guidelines as follows:

Under Convention Information – Responsibilities:

3. Schedule 2 distributions (at RSC) and 1 mailing (in June) as follows:

a) 100 pre-convention flyers handed out to each area at the Feb. RSC

b) 100 flyers handed out to each area at the August RSC

c) 50 flyers mailed to each Area outside the Region that is within 200 miles of the host city

d) 50 flyers mailed to each Region within 700 miles of the host city

5. In July, mail 1 flyer to each individual from outside the host city who registered for the prior year convention.

6. Delete – (no mailings to the WSC)

7. Delete – (no mailings to the World Convention)

Under Arts & Graphics – Responsibilities:

Section 2. – (pre-convention flyers) change “1,000 to be delivered to current VRC Convention” to “500 to be delivered to current VRC Convention”

Intent: to reduce the convention expense for printing and mailing flyers, since addicts are more likely to register from a flyer printed off the internet than from flyers distributed through the mail.

****Motion deferred to the Policy and Procedures subcommittee with instructions to get with current and incoming VRC chairs for input.***

Motion #2 was made by the Chattanooga Area and seconded by West Tn. Area and reads as follows:

The VRSC send \$10,000 of its funds to NAWS as a regional donation

Intent: to pass along extra funds so that they can be used to carry the message of NA

****Motion was deferred to the VRSC Treasurer for input.***

Motion #3 was made by VRC 28 Chair and seconded by Greater Smokey Mountain Area and reads as follows:

For the Region to purchase the web domains, VRCNA.org, VRCNA.com, and VRCNA.net for \$35.00 and allow all current VRC subcommittees to create and maintain a VRC website using these domains.

Intent: to have a website available for this VRC and all future VRC's

****Motion was voted unanimously in favor of.***

Motion #4 was made by the VRSC Outreach subcommittee and seconded by Mountain Area and reads as follows:

Hold an RCM orientation during the lunch break of the Dec. or Feb. RSC meeting. Outreach asks for 1 ½ hours for this event and will provide lunch.

Intent: To provide a welcome to new RCM's and inform new and experienced RCM's on RCM duties and Regional Services.

Comment – We have already voted to have the RCM orientation. This motion is not whether to have it or not. We are having the RCM orientation. This motion is to decide

whether to have the orientation during lunch break, when everyone will be here, or not. Either way, we are having the RCM orientation.

****Motion was voted on with 5 yes votes and 3 no votes. Motion passes.***

Motion #5 was made by the VRSC Secretary and seconded by Greater Nashville Area and reads as follows:

To hold the VRSC meeting at the Murfreesboro Jaycee's building starting in Dec. of '09 and continuing indefinitely, as well as holding the VRSC subcommittee's at Real Life Community church for the same time frame.

Cost : Jaycee's - \$125.00/day (7am to 10pm)

Real Life - \$25.00/day (as needed)

Intent: To host the VRSC and it's subcommittee's in a geographically centered location and be as financially prudent as possible.

Question – If we vote yes for this motion, will this mean we will start meeting for the VRSC at 9:30 in the morning again?

Answer – We are only the ad-hoc committee. That will be up to the chair.

ROR XV – The ROR 15 committee worked very hard to carry the message of NA. The Saturday night meeting was one of the largest in ROR history with approximately 200 members attending the meeting.

Many newcomer packages were given to those who stayed at the group camp. All 72 coffee cups were sold. There were a few t-shirts left over. T-shirts are now \$10 and we have about 15. We had 56 people actually register. Very low number, however, many members came to enjoy the day workshops and meetings. Future ROR committees may have a registration for "day" campers. ROR 15 did not have the kind of functions to raise funds, as in the past. Such as a golf tourney or

riverboat ride. The small functions we did were not supported very well. This in itself was disappointing. As most of the country, some of the problem was the economy as a whole. However, our donation to the Area is \$449.05. Although it may not be a sizable donation, such as past RORs, the funds were raised by those who worked their tails off to carry the message and provide a fun function. It was a fully self-supporting event.

I do hope there will not be as much controversy in the future, as there was with ROR 15. I hope future ROR chairs and committee members will not have to stand up for ROR and all it encompasses.

ROR 15 would like to thank those NA members who did attend the event and those who helped set up, do workshops, and those who showed their love for the fellowship and for ROR.
